Project Brief:

The Mobile Medical Unit (MMU), Assam project is an initiative of State Health Society, **National Health Mission (NHM)**, **Assam** and will be implemented by HLFPPT. It is a strategic initiative of the Government aimed at providing a range of health care services for populations living in remote, inaccessible, un-served and underserved areas mainly with the objective of taking healthcare service delivery to the doorsteps of these populations. The MMUs services are also intended to cater to the urban poor and vulnerable population and provide fixed services in areas where there is no health infrastructure.

<u>Schedule</u>

The MMUs shall follow the service plan/route plan/calendar for MMU as approved by the District Health officer/JDHS and accordingly make the services of the MMU available at the desired spot on the appointed days.

There will be at least 22 camp days and 2 non camp days in a month. Non camp days will be used for maintenance, refilling and data entry purposes.

Services:

The MMUs will provide primary and selective secondary out-patient health care services with an objective to "enhance the health and well- being of residents of the area covered by the MMU by providing high quality service, innovation and development and to meet identified needs within the resources available". Ailments which shall not normally require further referral/ specialist care will be treated at the MMU only. Patients will be treated and provided drugs free of cost. No charges of any kind will be recovered from the patients.

<u>Number of MMUs:</u> Total of 130 MMUs and 130 Auxiliary Vehicle will be deployed across 27 districts of Assam. Majority of the MMUs will be deployed in Tea Garden area. Each MMU comprises a Fully Equipped Vehicle for service delivery and an Auxiliary Vehicle for Commuting the MMU Team Members.

MMU Team

Each MMU Team comprises 9 members consisting of Medical Officer (MBBS), Nursing Staff (02), Pharmacist, Lab Technician, Ophthalmic Technician, Drivers (2) and a Handyman. For 130 MMUs, a total of 1170 members will be deployed on ground.

Job Descriptions

(1) **Job Title:** Medical Officer (MBBS)

Travel involved: Local travel

Key Roles & Responsibilities of Medical Officer (MBBS):

- Support the team in the development of route plan for the MMU;
- Provide preventive, promotive and curative health care and referral services to patients during MMU-OPDs;
- Document processes and maintain health records of patients as per project requirement;
- Utilize, supervise and manage stock of medicines, healthcare products and reagents for regular MMU services:
- Supervise safe disposal of biomedical wastes;
- Liaise and interact with other medical, non-medical staff, health department officials and community members and create and maintain positive image of the organization and the State Health Society, NHM, Assam for the services delivered;
- Network with other medical professionals/ specialists in and around the project site and solicit their support as and when need arises;
- Encourage health literacy amongst the target audience:
- Supervise functions and quality of services of the MMU technical team;
- Provide regular need-based technical training to MMU team;
- Support the team in compilation and submission of progress report; and
- Perform other tasks which may be assigned by the reporting manager from time to time.

The candidate should have a professional degree (MBBS), registered with Medical Council, with a minimum of 1-2 years of experience (or a retired active MBBS doctor) with strong public health care skills. Female candidates are encouraged to apply.

 - ✓ Education (group and inter-personal) and motivation for Family Welfare Services;
 - ✓ Education and delivery of MCH Services (Antenatal, Post-natal Immunization etc.);
 - ✓ Education regarding nutrition;
 - ✓ Follow up of cases of sterilization, IUD distribution of Nirodh & Oral Pills, a follow up of antenatal, post-natal, infant cases registered by her in the OPD;
- N Other tasks which may be assigned by the reporting manager from time to time.

She should have GNM qualification or an ANM qualification from any nursing school or institution recognized by the Indian Nursing Council and registered with "Assam Nurses' Midwives' and Health Visitors' Council". Candidates with 1 year (or more) of professional experience will be given preference.

- Maintaining the stock of relevant lab consumables;

- Provide information on expenditure on drugs;
- Prepare and quality-check sterile medications, for example, intravenous medications;
